**WHAT:** California African American Museum (CAAM) presents the Carter G. Woodson African American History Series #4: *The Frederick Douglass and Booker T. Washington Connection*. Kenneth Morris, Jr., president of the Frederick Douglass Family Foundation (FDFP) has the distinct honor of sharing and preserving his family pedigree. Morris will give a PowerPoint presentation and lecture on the lives and legacies of his great-great grandfathers, Frederick Douglass and Booker T. Washington.

**WHY:** FDFP's mission is to create a sound awareness of modern-day slavery in an effort to expedite its demise. Modern-day slavery includes human trafficking, chattel slavery, debt bondage, sex slavery, forced labor and child soldiers.
